Dear parents, guardians, and young people

Term 2 will commence on Monday, 20 April. You can choose to keep your young person at home, or you may choose to send your young person to the campus for supervision.

Regardless of where your young person's learning will take place, they will be delivered the *Learning From Home* program (on campus supervision will not be a normal classroom environment).

#### **An overview**

The program has been designed to maximise continuity of learning by reflecting the AITC's unique five-week education block and a five-week industry block model. Group 1 and Group 2 will remain for this reason.

The *Learning From Home* program employs a blended learning approach, whereby teachers and industry consultants will use a range of methods to deliver learning.

Learning has been pre-prepared and will be mainly self-directed day-by-day through a structured timetable.

A detailed *Learning From Home* handbook will be emailed to you tomorrow to guide you through the program. The timetable will be available on Student Café and learning materials will be accessible via Schoology – a platform our young people are familiar with – from Friday afternoon.
