

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

Minimum & Recommended Specifications 2024

The Australian Industry Trade College has a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program, requiring young people to bring a computing device (laptop or a notebook) to college.

Whilst working at college, young people will wirelessly connect into the AITC network and will be provided access to all the software and systems required to support their education. Young people working at home can still access the AITC network through their home internet connection, to gain access to the college software & services. Below are the minimum & recommended specifications required for the laptop/device:

Recommended Accessories

- **External mouse:** allows the Young person to use their device quicker and more accurately than the built-in touch pad.
- **Laptop Carry Case/Sleeve:** provides a layer of protection for the device when being transported

Software

The device must be installed with an Anti-Virus & Anti-Malware Software.

AITC provides free access to the required software and services the Young Person will utilise during their education.
